Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, Indemnification: **Effective January 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022**

In consideration for my participation or attendance at all NPBHA events between January 1, 2022 - December 31, 2022, I AGREE to all of the following: I choose to participate voluntarily in the event with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, leasee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, auditor, spectator, groom, or as a parent/guardian of a junior participating in the event. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, serious bodily injury, including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, and even death ("Harm").

I release the NPBHA, any employees, personnel, sponsors, volunteers, or agents (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for money, damages, or otherwise for any Harm to me, my horse(s) or my personal property and for any Harm caused by me or my horse(s) to others, even Harm resulted directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Indemnified Parties.

I expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Indemnified Parties. I shall indemnify (that is, to pay any all all losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Indemnified Parties and to hold them harmless with respect to all claims for Harm to me or my horse(s), and for claims made by others or any claim made by others for any Harm caused to me or my horse(s) at the NPBHA event.

I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and ability to safely participate in the NPBHA Event. By signing below, I agree to all terms of this release, assumption of risk, waiver and indemnification.
